

# Eijsden-Margraten: river Maas connecting with Albert Canal




# Eindhoven: Beatrix Canal connecting with Wilhelmina Canal





# Our shared objectives:





- Safe sailing at joint use of waterways by boating and commercial shipping in Eindhoven and Eijsden-Margraten and border region
- Setting up a mobile App systeem for information waterway users





# Our shared program of requirements:

- Safety for all users
- Including communication possibilities in case of calamities or specific situations
  - Linking different types of information facilities
  - Make the best use of available (open) data (for example from AIS)



# Our specific requirements:



## Eijsden-Margraten:

- where possible, cross-border interconnections
- applications with multilingual communication (DU, FR, EN, GER)

## **Eindhoven:**

possibility of automatically collecting harbour dues



## Joint solutions:



- a mobile App or/or in combination with a mobile website
  - no separate means of communication
    - use native technology
- specific solutions needed for cross-border links (such as an off-line functionality)
  - no 'stand-alone' App (integration of functions such as tourist, economic etc.)

## Eindhoven:

automated payment system for collecting port dues
